

## Bedford Drive Primary School 2017-18

### Early Years Foundation Stage(EYFS) 2017/18

60% of children achieved a Good Level of Development(GLD) (National 71.5% 2018)

### Phonics Screening 2017/18

80% of the children in Year 1 met the expected standard in the Phonics Screening Check (National 83% 2018)

96% of the children retested in Year 2 met the expected standard in the Phonics Screening Check (National 92% 2017)

Children sitting the Key Stage 2 tests this year were the second cohort to be taught and assessed under the new national curriculum.

Expected standard has been raised with the new national curriculum.

## Progress 2017/18

A school achieves sufficient progress scores in **all three subjects** reading, writing and mathematics if the average progress scores of Year 6 pupils are at least **-5** in English reading, **-5** in mathematics and **-7** in writing. At Bedford Drive the progress scores do not differ significantly from national as they are within the confidence interval.
